MEDICAL ATTENTION

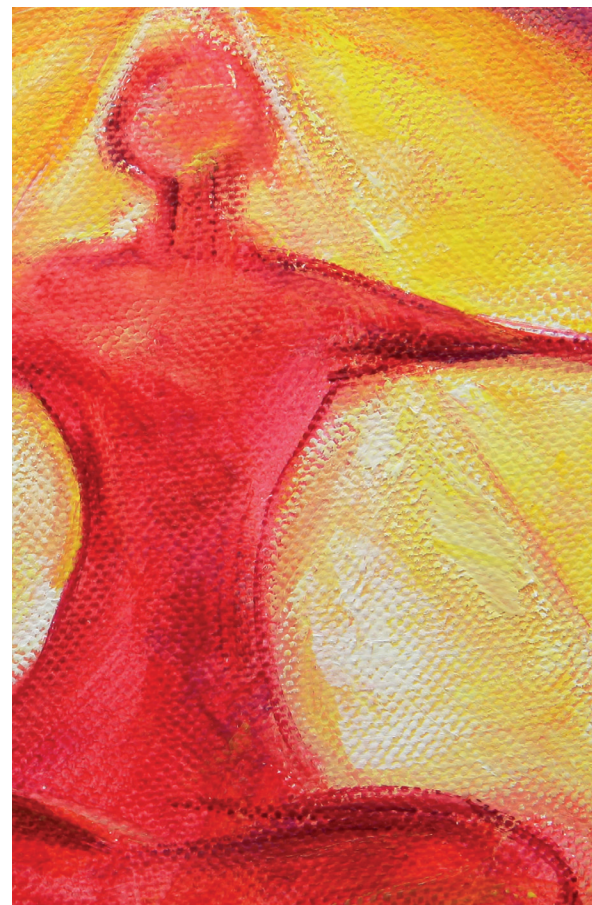
- There is a nurse on staff for the retreat and First Aid will be available. For emergencies, 911 may be contacted through the front desk at Kanuga Retreat Center.
